

Session Plan (15 mins)

Should uncontacted tribes be left alone?



Timing	Activity	Slide(s)
N/A	Feedback: Allow students some time to read the feedback on the topic we did on sharenting	2
2 minutes	Starter: Tribal tourism: Ask the students to focus on the images and read the information on this. Feedback initial ideas.	3
1 minute	Introduce the topic for discussion: We have joined with SAPERE to help students do philosophy. There is more information on the final two slides.	4
4 minutes	Why are we talking about this? Begin by asking if any students recognise the pictures from the news. Then click to watch a video on this story.	5
3 minutes	What threatens their survival? Discuss some of the threats to these tribes' survival, before introducing the main activity on when, if ever they should be contacted.	6
5 minutes	Can ethical contact be made? Discuss the two moral dilemmas on whether uncontacted tribes should be supported. Reflect on how difficult it is to make these decisions.	7
N/A	Career launchpad: Students can use this to learn more about uncontacted tribes and also look at the role of a documentary filmmaker that specialises in portraying different cultures.	8
1 minute	Yes/No summary: Encourage students to reflect on this topic before they vote.	9
