

## Session Plan KS2 (30-60 minutes)

# Should uncontacted tribes be left alone?



Timing	Activity	Slide(s)
N/A	<b>Feedback:</b> Take a look at the feedback from the topic we did on sharenting.	2
5 minutes	<b>Starter: What do you think of me?</b> Ask pupils to look at the image and write down a couple of words to describe what they think. Share with the class. Discuss why they have these thoughts.	3
3 minutes	<b>Introduce the topic:</b> Give time for initial thoughts. What do they think this lesson is about?	4
3 minutes	<b>Our partner this week:</b> Share with pupils the work we are doing with SAPERE, especially if you are a Philosophy for Children school. There is more information on the final two slides.	5
15 minutes	<b>What are uncontacted tribes?</b> Read the information and reveal the pictures to help pupils understand what an uncontacted tribe is. On slide 8 watch the video to learn more. Use the pictures on slide 9 to discover some of the threats these tribes face.	7-9
5 minutes	<b>Why are we talking about this?</b> Read about the news story and then discuss what they think about this. Was what the Sentinelese did wrong?	11
15 minutes	<b>Is it right to leave uncontacted tribes alone?</b> In pairs, pupils should discuss each of the four scenarios on the cards, focusing on what they think about the person in bold and whether they are making a positive contribution. Then on slide 14, draw out how this activity compares to how tribes might feel about people trying to change their way of life. Using slide 15, ask pupils on tables to think about these two difficult situations and whether they would contact the tribes in these circumstances. Take feedback from the tables.	13-15
10-15 minutes	<b>Design your own tribe:</b> Using the images and supporting ideas on slide 17, ask the pupils to design their own tribe. Share some of the ideas with the class.	17
N/A	<b>Career Launchpad:</b> Use this slide to learn more and think about a career linked to the topic.	18
2 minutes	<b>Yes/No summary:</b> Consider the 2 different sides of the debate before voting.	20-21
